IN GENERAL

During your experience you will be an active part of the team and expected to get involved and take responsibility. To the extent that whilst your guide will have to oversee safety and the experience in general, the emphasis will remain on yourself to adhere to training and become an involved, responsible and active team member. We will provide adequate training and support to ensure you are able to do this and your adventure remains a top class experience. All outdoor leaders are deemed as competent to fulfil this role and will normally hold relevant experience, qualifications and a manner to facilitate your choice of activity. The pace of the experience will have to be a balance between group needs and the actual activity. Flexibility is needed from all to account for changes in weather, dealing with individual or group needs and wild animals; this attitude is especially needed, when on expeditions to **East Africa**. You should also expect that whether we are facilitating the **Urban Adventure** programme amongst Glasgow urban park land or indeed on expedition to East Africa the general ethos and ethics of the company will still be adhered to including the Eco policy. All experiences will contain some amount of information about Natural history.

Our **Outdoor team** are carefully selected and regularly reminded of the ethos through training and updates; they also enjoy what they do. The **equipment** you receive is the best we are able to offer, regularly checked for serviceability and clean.

-  **Loch Lomond Canoe Safari's** guided open canoe journeys single or multi day, typically an experience will train adventurers to control their two person craft with basic skills and also ensure they have basic safety knowledge, prior to a during journeys. Canoe safaris make use of the scenic areas within a 45 min journey time from Glasgow.
-  **Urban Adventure** guided canoe trips and walks exploring the green space within and around Glasgow city boundaries. Including classic venues such as green space along The River Kelvin, River Clyde and the Forth & Clyde canal. Surprisingly the chances of spotting a variety of bird life, urban foxes and even shy Roe deer are quite high.
-  **Wild by Nature** Mountain trekking and bush craft themed experiences within a 45 min journey time from Glasgow. Taking in either the high peaks of the southern highlands with your guide or exploring the intimate lower woods or moorland areas.



Eco Expeditions to East Africa. Expeditions will have a UK training element and carry a specific aim. Typically lasting 16 days, exploring by canoe and on foot with the addition of Scuba diving based near Mombasa within Bamburi National marine reserve.
